- The successful candidate will be awarded a certificate, engraved glass trophy, entered into Hall of Fame, and free registration at the next three EUROSENSORS conferences.

Selection Criteria for the EUROSENSORS Fellow Award 2026

The following criteria will be considered when evaluating nominations for the EUROSENSORS Fellow Award 2026.

The Award aims to:

- Recognize and encourage outstanding contributions to the EUROSENSORS community
- Promote continued participation in EUROSENSORS through high-quality scientific contributions
- Enhance the impact and visibility of the EUROSENSORS conference series
- Support the professional development of the award recipient

Candidates should ideally:

- Be researchers or professionals from academia or industry who are at a rising stage of their career
- Have actively participated in and made significant contributions to the success of past EUROSENSORS conferences
- Have demonstrated measurable scientific impact in the field, including contributions associated with EUROSENSORS
- Have the potential to serve as good ambassadors for the EUROSENSORS community

The winner of the award will be selected by the EUROSENSORS Fellow Committee and announced during the social dinner of EUROSENSORS 2026.
